

Port Mann construction webcams now set up February 17, 2010

It's now possible to watch the new Port Mann Bridge gradually take shape on the Internet via streaming web cams.

The transportation ministry has set up cameras at five sites along the Highway 1 corridor to track project construction.

Two views show the in-river construction as well as the work on the south and east approaches, as well as the new South Fraser Perimeter Road.

Cameras are also positioned at Johnson Hill in Surrey, the Cape Horn Interchange, King Edward Street in Coquitlam and the Grandview Highway Overpass in Burnaby.

The \$3.1-billion project includes construction of the new 10-lane bridge to replace the existing span and the widening of Highway 1 over 37 kilometres from Vancouver to 216 Street in Langley, with multiple interchange upgrades.

The work is to be finished by December 2012.
