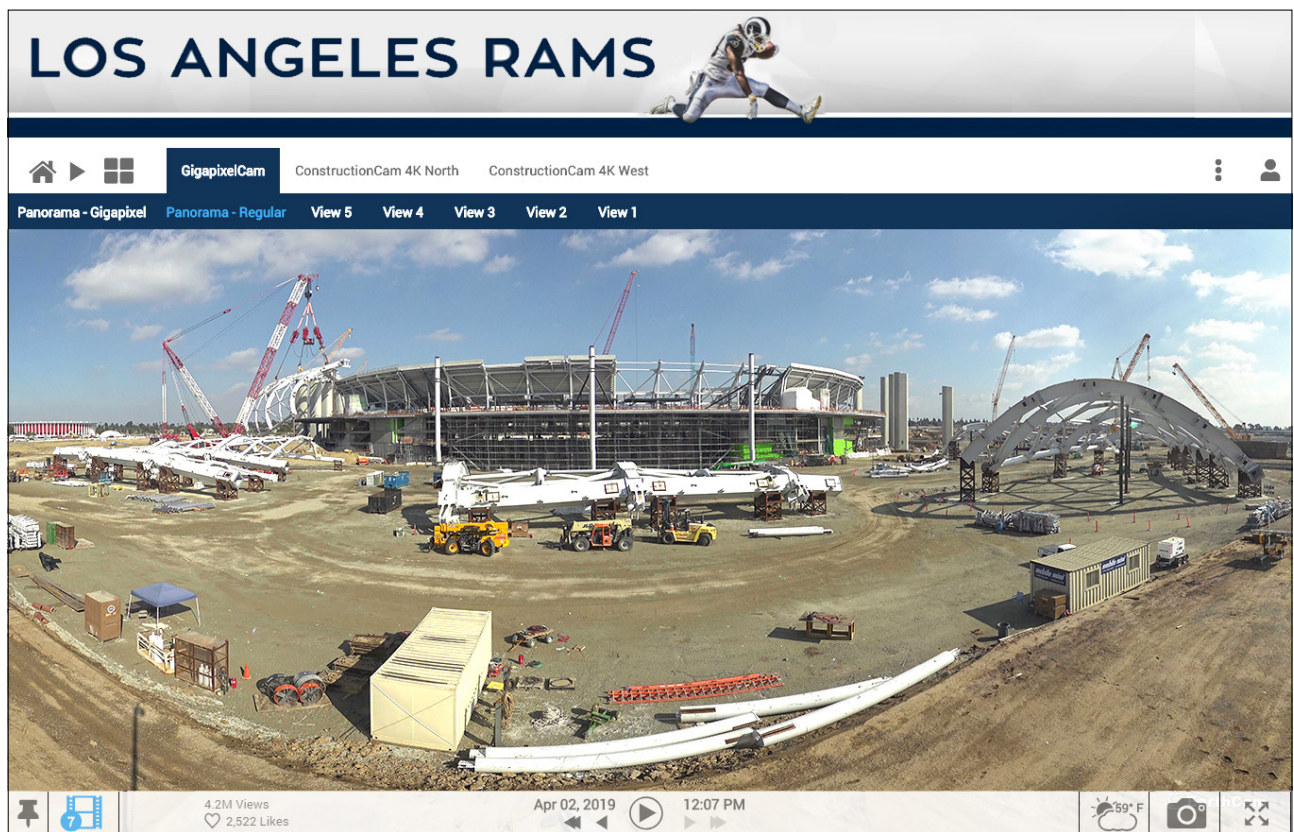


## Look: Rams' new stadium hits milestone as last piece of outer roof truss is installed

The Los Angeles Rams have just one season left at the Coliseum before they move into their new digs in Inglewood. The massive stadium is still under construction and is expected to be completed in 2020, just in time for the NFL season.

Both the Rams and Chargers will call Inglewood home, and the stadium is really taking shape with just over a year until it's finished. The venue will house more than just the Rams and Chargers — NFL Media will move in as well.
